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What is Title I?

What Is It?

The KIPP Soul Academy Parent and Family Engagement Plan for Shared Student Success was created to improve family engagement opportunities that support student learning at school and home. How is it developed?

KIPP Soul Academy welcomes parent feedback at any time regarding this plan. All parent feedback will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view throughout the year. We also distribute an annual survey online to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and use of Title I funds for family academic engagement. This plan is finalized and approved by members of the KIPP Soul Academy Family Parent Engagement and School Leadership Teams annually in the Fall.

Who is it for?

This plan is for all scholars participating in the Title I, Part A program and their families. All families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. KIPP Soul Academy provides complete opportunity for participation of parents who speak languages other than English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

In the beginning of the school year, this plan will be sent home with all of our students. This plan will be distributed at the Annual Title I Parent Meeting held annually in the Fall. The plan is also posted on the KIPP Soul Academy website under School Resources. Families may also retrieve a copy of this plan in the Parent Center located inside the main office of our school.

- Scholars will increase reading levels by 1.5 grade levels (measured by Lexile & STAR Assessment data) and increase average math proficiency on Milestones by 20%.
- KIPP Soul Academy will have a 0% expulsion rate and less than 5% suspension rate.

- Ensure that all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is posted in our Parent Resource Center, shared via ParentSquare, and included in the weekly newsletter for all parents.
- Work with our parents to develop relevant training and helpful presentations to educate our staff on the importance of family academic engagement and strategies to improve communication with parents. Staff will also share best practices during regularly scheduled faculty meetings.
