AS A SCHOOL.

Double-block 9th Grade Coordinate Algebra. Blended learning instruction in all math classes. Intervention classes for math that utilizes flexible grouping and Individualized instruction; SPED-certified staff providing Intervention support. We will provide Intervention classes for reading that utilizes flexible grouping and Individualized instruction.

Double-block in 9th Grade ELA.
The required double block ELA
class provides double the time (100
minutes) for students to focus on
the 9th grade ELA standards
focusing on listenting, speaking and
writing. This course Is mandatory
for graduation for all scholars.

AS A Parent..

I will utilize resources recommended by the school to give my scholar extra support with math at home. I will promote positive use of extracurricular time such as participating In academic clubs, extra tutorial, educational trips and reading more at home. I will regularly review my scholar's binders and assignments and encourage my scholar to rework challenging assignments, quizzes and tests to support learning at home.

AS A Student

I will dedicate 1/2 hour of ACT Math practice each night in addition to the timely completion of all homework and project assignments.
