

OUR SCHOOL

Founded in 2011, KIPP Atlanta Collegiate High School was the fifth KIPP Atlanta School to open and is the only KIPP high school in Atlanta. KIPP Atlanta Collegiate is located in the heart of southwest Atlanta. KAC is housed in the Henry McNeal Turner High School building, formerly a segregated public school that opened in 1951. At KAC, we strive to be a cornerstone in our community that is unapologetically committed to ensuring every scholar grows up free to create the future they want for themselves and their communities.



COVID-19 IMPACT

In March of 2020, KIPP Atlanta Schools, alongside many districts in the metropolitan Atlanta area, transitioned to virtual instruction in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Throughout the 2021-2022 academic year, our instruction evolved to include concurrent in-person and virtual instruction, with approximately 22% of our scholars choosing virtual participation. We embark on the 2024-2025 academic year by welcoming all scholars back to KIPP Atlanta Collegiate for in-person instruction. KIPP Atlanta Collegiate remains committed to equipping our scholars with the knowledge and skills necessary for a successful post-secondary journey.

While we are grateful for the renewed sense of normalcy, we acknowledge the challenges and disruptions that our seniors faced as they navigated through unprecedented times. We appreciate your open-mindedness and understanding as you consider our scholars.

STANDARDIZED TESTING

393 Advanced Placement exams were administered in the 2023-2024 academic year.

Scholars within the 2025 graduating cohort have an average composite **ACT** score of 16 and an average **SAT score of 910**.

ATLANTA COLLEGE AND CAREER ACADEMY (ACCA)

Scholars have the option to participate in the Atlanta College and Career Academy (ACCA). ACCA is an Atlanta Public Schools and Atlanta Technical College partnership for those interested in college and Career Technical Education courses. This program enables scholars to receive college credit, certification for select pathways, and a certificate of participation upon completion. This program also prepares scholars for dual enrollment. The minimum GPA for participation is 2.0. ACCA is exclusively offered to grades 10th -12th. A total of 34 KAC scholars are currently enrolled in ACCA.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES

KIPP Atlanta Collegiate scholars have the choice to participate in any of the twelve AP course offerings. There are no prerequisite requirements, such as teacher recommendations, test scores, or grades to participate. AP Calculus BC and AP Research are exceptions; scholars must take Pre-Calculus or AP Seminar to participate. These courses may be taken in core subjects or the AP Capstone program.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

KAC began partnering with local colleges for dual enrollment in 2015. We currently have 58 scholars participating in the Fall 2024 semester. Scholars are dually enrolled at Georgia State University, Atlanta Metropolitan College, or Atlanta Technical College.
