- **Discussion Items**
 - A. **End of Year Data Discussion: I Ready**
 - Ms. O said we would look at data surprised us, what made it stand out, what concerns do we have, and what areas of excellence do we want to celebrate
 - She grounded us in the fact that when we look at data we can stay informed to share it with others in the community
 - Ms. O shared the EOY data to show our projections to see if we would be on track for Milestones since we cannot see Milestones data yet
 - Ms. O said that we are not on track right now with 20% proficiency and 48% developing and above
 - Ms. O gave pace for folks to share any celebrations or concerns
 1. No one did
 2. Ms. O shared that this is high concern for her as an ELA teacher and what can she talk about with the scholars & do over the summer to help mitigate
 3. Dr. Lyon asked us to go back (when we got to math) and said Grade 4 is a concern as they got worse
 4. Ms Odum said grade 3 has grown some but how to we move the lowest scholars to get them red to orange
 - Math data:
 1. Ms. O named that math is approaching with 21% proficient and 58% developing and above
 2. Ms. Stifler chimed in when Ms. O lost volume and named that Math is doing a little better, but that 3-4 is doing much better than the older grades.
 - Growth Targets IReady
 1. No grade met the growth target
 - a. Ms. Okulaja said there were some things to celebrate with kids meeting goals (personal goals)
 - b. She pushed teammates to share celebrations or concerns but no one did so she then shared math data
 - i. Kindergarten was a bright spot with the most meeting the target
 - c. Ms. O named that as we talk about KWPA's story we get a wider lens of KWPA's story and how can we keep the momentum going of what kindergarten is able to do

- d. For Lexile growth we are not on track, but we have had a lot of growth—we doubled our growth from 19% to 38% and we can celebrate that!
- e. Ms. O showed that by grade some grades really did grow a lot, and while we are not still on track, make sure we still do share the whole story
- f. No one shared

B. End of Year Data Discussion: Attendance

- Ms. O said attendance is something to celebrate and that it is consistent. Kids are coming more than last year and shared things to celebrate and what supports KWPA is doing related to attendance
- Ms. O highlighted 3, 6, 7 are coming a lot and that we are as a school 10 higher than last year
- Ms. O reminded everyone of the questions—surprises, concerns, what to celebrate and share


● **Information Items**

A. Principal's Update: Progress towards Family & Culture Goals

- Ms. Stifler shared updates on our last two goals—Family and Culture
- She reminded us that Family Love is the average of the score from the fall and spring One Voice survey that KIPP Woodson Park families take during both seasons. The school goal this year was to average 72, 3 points higher than last year
- KWPA met the goal with an average of 74! The score was higher in the fall than the spring, which is typical. KWPA was much higher than the KIPP Atlanta average and families feel that overall the school is positive, communicative, supportive, and that they have someone to talk to
- For the Culture goal Ms. Stifler reminded us that the total was to be 150. Last year that was also the goal but the school missed it by over 30. With 14 days left this year KWPA is on track with a total of 77! This is a big decrease. Ms. Stifler named that it isn't because the school just isn't suspending, and in fact they have only declined 2 suspensions this year that did not align to the APS handbook. Instead, it's because year over year scholars are more bought in to what it means to be a Warrior, and teachers are working diligently to be restorative and help scholars learn from decisions—the whole point of consequences is to change behavior, and that is happening each year
