In order to build an effective home-school partnership, KIPP Atlanta Collegiate will prove the following:

- 5 Continuous communication to assist parents in understanding the curriculum and student achievement through weekly electronic newsletters, regular progress reports, KAC Student and Parent Handbook, Principal and Parents Partnering meetings, and daily access to the KAC Parent Resource Center.
 - Blackboard Learning System, ParentSquare, and APS Infinite Campus ParentPortal;
 - KAC PTSA, Sounds of Royalty Band Booster and Athletic Boosters; and
 - Opportunities to volunteer and participate in classroom activities and field studies.

- 7 All parents are provided with a copy of the annual school review results, including the school performance profile.
