Our Commitment

At KIPP Vision Campus, we are committed to creating continuous opportunities to connect with our families. Family partnership is essential to scholar success, and we value what every family member contributes toward our shared goal of achievement. This plan outlines how KIPP Vision Campus will support parent and family engagement throughout the year, and the ways families can participate, plan, and promote growth through our campus events and activities. We are dedicated to engaging **all** families, kindergarten through eighth grade, regardless of race, gender, language, or ability.

What is Title I?

Title I, Part A is a federally funded program under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Its purpose is to ensure all children have a fair and equal chance to receive a high-quality education and meet state academic standards. Title I funding provides additional support so schools can close achievement gaps and raise scholar success. A key part of Title I is the partnership between school and family — keeping families informed of scholar progress, ensuring access to high-quality teaching, aligning instruction with challenging state standards, and building strong two-way communication.

Title I resources discussed with families include staffing support, scholar meals, uniforms, classroom technology, and family engagement resources.

How is our plan developed?

Family voices shape this work. Parents are encouraged to share feedback on this plan at any time during the year, including at every KIPP Family Network (KFN) meeting and at our family input sessions with campus leaders. All feedback gathered throughout the year is used to strengthen the plan and guide revisions for the following school year. Copies are available in the Main Office and on ParentSquare, our family communication app.

WHO IS IT FOR?

All scholars in the Title I, Part A program and their families. Vision provides full opportunity for participation by parents who speak languages other than English, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children.

WHERE IS IT AVAILABLE?

Sent home at the start of the year, distributed at the Annual Title I Parent Meeting in the Fall, posted on ParentSquare, and available in the Parent Center inside the main office.

KIPP Vision Campus Academic Achievement Goals

From the KIPP Vision Campus 2026–2027 Continuous Improvement Plan:

ELA GOAL

24% → 40%

of K–5 scholars on or above grade level in iReady ELA, and grades 6–8 from **57% → 70%**.

MATH GOAL

64.7% → 75%

of grades 3–5 Developing Learner+ on GMAS Math, and grades 6–8 Proficient Learner+ from **26.8% → 35%**.

WHOLE CHILD

75%+

K–8 CCRPI attendance maintained, and scholars with 4+ behavior incidents reduced from **1.1% → 0.5%**.

EVERY SCHOLAR, EVERY DAY

Our attendance goal is for 85% of scholars to attend more than 90% of the year. Families support this by getting scholars to school on time every day, communicating when an absence is necessary, and partnering with our attendance support team when needed.

How we will strengthen school–family connections

KIPP Vision Campus will take the following measures to promote and strengthen our partnership with families, recognizing parents as essential partners in our community. These commitments mirror our Family Compact promise to communicate clearly, teach well, engage families, and model the Vision values.

COMMUNICATE CONSISTENTLY

- **ParentSquare** — our primary platform for announcements, events, surveys, and updates
- **Weekly newsletter** — dates, campus updates, engagement opportunities, attendance reminders
- **Weekly folders** — printed scholar and family information
- **Parent Center** — paper copies for families who need printed materials
- **Teacher communication** — families may request a conversation any time, not only at conferences; staff respond within 24 hours

PROVIDE ACADEMIC SUPPORT

- Tutoring for scholars who need it through master teachers, extended learning, and community partners
- Strategies and materials shared with families at academic nights, report card conferences, and workshops
- Daily reading at home supported with resources that grow Lexile and DIBELS performance

EMPOWER STAFF & FAMILIES TOGETHER

- Staff training on effective family communication and engagement
- Family representatives on campus committees with leaders and community stakeholders
- Families partner with staff to keep learning environments safe, respectful, and supportive

SUPPORT TRANSITIONS & GROWTH

- Primary to Academy transition events: Principal Forums, Family Nights, and Preview Days
- Celebrations of scholar progress through showcases and community events

A place for all to be involved

Engagement starts with knowing how your scholar is doing academically, behaviorally, and socially. **Academics:** use Infinite Campus for graded assignments, review progress reports and report cards, attend conferences and academic nights, and talk with your scholar’s teacher. **Behavior:** review points and staff updates in your scholar’s behavior platform — contact the front office if you need access information.

Your voice matters

SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT

The Family Compact is a written agreement between the school community and parents describing how we share the effort to raise scholar achievement. Compacts are reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents, scholars, and teachers.
